
This orientation program gave the parents an elaborate idea on each of the curriculum and what the next two years of high school will be for their children.




# Theory of Knowledge

On the 14th of August, DP 1 students presented objects related to a TOK concept. There are 12 of these concepts, which includes: certainty, culture, evidence, explanation, interpretation, justification, objectivity, perspective, power, responsibility, truth, values.
